Subject: Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emissions Inventory Report

Beginning in March, 2023 the District partnered with Mott MacDonald to begin the process of completing the District's first ever Greenhouse Gas Emissions Inventory.


The GHG inventory included CY 2022 Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions. Data for Scope 1 was calculated based on the purchased quantities of commercial fuels using published emission factors and Scope 2 emissions were primarily sourced from metered electricity along with supplier or grid-based emissions factors.

After completing the GHG inventory, Mott MacDonald conducted a three-hour in-person training session with key Cherriots staff, and covered the following topics:


- GHG emissions overview
- GHG emission methodology, assumptions, and gaps
- Interpretation of findings and hotspots
- Detailed explanation of recommendations and opportunities for improvement
- Tracking of emissions over time
- Next steps and discussion




