    - 4. Trust resulting from communication and respect
      - 5. Separate roles & responsibilities

## Key Points!!

1	There is no single relationship in the organization that is more important as that between the board and its executive/CEO.
2	The board and executive must devote regular attention to their relationship for the health of the organization.
3	High-functioning board-executive relationships start with clear agreement on roles & responsibilities.
4	The specifics of the distinct roles & responsibilities between a board and executive are unique and up to every organization to define.
5	The principles of a healthy board executive partnership include recognition of interdependence, focus on results, mutual accountability, trust and separate roles/responsibilities.
6	If the relationship between the board and executive needs to change, devote time & resources to it. It will be one of the best investments you make in the organization.
